## HISTORY:

Documented by Greeks, Romans and Arabs. Carlos III colonized the island with Genovese fishermen released in the port of Tabarka, Tunisia. The first constructions date from 1760 ordered by the Count of Randa. In 1969 it was declared an Asset of Cultural Interest. In 1989, it was declared the first Spanish Marine Reserve



**Wall surrounding the city. There are three baroque gates (s XVIII): The one of San Rafael, the one of San Gabriel and the one of San Miguel**




## **CHURCH OF SAN PEDRO AND SAN PABLO:**

**Baroque church dating from 1769. It was declared Asset of Cultural Interest in 1964 along with the rest of the island**

**Main street of the Island of Tabarca. You will find shops bars and restaurants**

**Emblematic building of the s. XVIII**

**Cabo Roig:** Heading a course to the North, Cabo Roig is 10 miles far away from our leaving departure point. We will enjoy the bath and we will visit a very old defense tower of the XVIth Century converted into a wine cellar with very old red wines.

**Isla Grossa:** In front of the Marina Tomás Maestre, we will find “Isla Grossa”. This island named as Grossa is the second highest Island in Murcia. On this Island you can find a kind of protected seagull and some hawks. We can take a buoy in front of the Island and enjoy the bath



**Torreveija:** Heading a course to the North Torreveija is 13,5 miles far away from our leaving departure point. It is one of the most important cities of Alicante. We will anchor on the shore of the beach known as “Acequión”, the only Spanish beach inside a Marina where anchoring is allowed
